## **Understanding "The Fourth Dimension" in Light of Scripture**

### **Spiritual Sight:**

We are using "Fourth Dimension" to describe the spiritual realm that influences the visible world. Shepherd Lambur teaches that prayer, faith, vision, and the Holy Spirit connect believers to God's supernatural activity. The phrase "fourth dimension" is a concept of expressing of the unseen spiritual realm that is real and that believers are called to walk in communion with God within that realm.

### **Within This Dimension:**

- **The Kingdom of God**
- **The Kingdom of Heaven**
- **The heavenly places**
- **The Spirit**
- **The glory of God**
- **The presence of God**
- **Abiding in Messiah Yahshua**
- **Fellowship with the Holy Spirit**

## **1. The Invisible Realm Is Real**

**The Bible teaches that there is more than the physical world.**

**"For we walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7)**

**"For the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal." (2 Corinthians 4:18)**

**"Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God." (Hebrews 11:3)**

**The visible world came from the invisible realm of God's power.**

---

## **2. The Kingdom of God Is Present**

**Yahshua taught that the Kingdom is not merely a future location.**

**"The kingdom of God is within you." (Luke 17:21)**

**"Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." (Matthew 4:17)**

**"Seek ye first the kingdom of God." (Matthew 6:33)**

**The Kingdom becomes experienced as believers submit to the rule and presence of God.**

---

## **3. Access Into the Spiritual Realm**

**The doorway is not techniques.**

**The doorway is Yahshua.**

**"I am the door." (John 10:9)**

**"I am the way, the truth, and the life." (John 14:6)**

**"Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Yahshua." (Hebrews 10:19)**

**The believer's access to God's presence comes through Messiah.**

---

## **4. Abiding Opens Spiritual Awareness**

**Yahshua taught abiding.**

**John 15:1-11**

**"Abide in me, and I in you." (John 15:4)**

**"He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit." (John 15:5)**

**The more deeply believers abide in Him, the more they become sensitive to His leading and presence.**

---

## **5. The Holy Spirit Reveals the Realm of God**

**"Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard... but God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit." (1 Corinthians 2:9-10)**

**"The Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God." (1 Corinthians 2:10)**

**The Holy Spirit opens spiritual understanding.**

---

## **6. The Heavenly Places**

**One of the most important passages is Ephesians.**

**"Blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Messiah." (Ephesians 1:3)**

**"Raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Messiah Yahshua." (Ephesians 2:6)**

**Believers are physically on earth but spiritually united with Messiah.**

---

## **7. Walking in the Spirit**

**"Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh." (Galatians 5:16)**

**"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit." (Galatians 5:25)**

**The spiritual realm becomes experiential through continual fellowship with the Holy Spirit.**

## **8. The Glory Realm of God's Presence**

**Throughout Scripture, God's presence is associated with glory.**

**Moses**

**Exodus 33:11**

**"The LORD spake unto Moses face to face."**

**Exodus 34:29**

**Moses' face shone.**

**Solomon**

**2 Chronicles 5:13-14**

**The glory filled the temple.**

**Isaiah**

**Isaiah 6:1-8**

**The prophet encountered the throne room.**

**Ezekiel**

**Ezekiel 1**

**Ezekiel saw visions of God.**

**These reveal encounters with God's manifest presence.**

## **9. The "Orah Sphere" Concept**

**The term "Orah Sphere" is found in Scripture starting with 1 John 1:6-7.**

**The "Orah Sphere" means living within God's light, glory, presence, and anointing, which proceeds to receive the life of Messiah being poured upon and into believers. Emanation is where His anointing is received being in His daily presence. The scripture contains many parallels that explain this communion with God .**

**Walking in His Light**

**"God is light." (1 John 1:5)**

**"Walk in the light." (1 John 1:7)**

**Surrounded by His Presence**

**"In thy presence is fulness of joy." (Psalm 16:11)**

**Dwelling in His Glory**

**"Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee." (Isaiah 60:1)**

**Covered by His Presence**

**"He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty." (Psalm 91:1)**

**David practices being with the Lord we see this in evidence in the Psalms!**

**These verses describe believers living in continual awareness of God's presence.**

## **10. Conditions That Increase Spiritual Sensitivity**

**Prayer**

**Acts 4:31**

**"When they had prayed... they were all filled with the Holy Ghost."**

**Worship**

**Acts 13:2**

**"As they ministered to the Lord."**

**Waiting Upon God**

**Isaiah 40:31**

**Meditation on the Word**

**Joshua 1:8**

**Psalms 1:2-3**

**Obedience**

**John 14:21**

**"I will love him, and will manifest myself to him."**

**Obedience increases spiritual perception.**

---

## **11. Examples of Believers Entering Deeper Spiritual Experiences**

**Stephen**

**Acts 7:55**

**"Being full of the Holy Spirit, looked up steadfastly into heaven."**

**Peter**

**Acts 10:9-16**

**Received a vision while praying.**

**Paul**

**2 Corinthians 12:1-4**

**Caught up into heavenly experiences.**

**John**

**Revelation 1:10**

**"I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day."**

**These experiences occurred through relationship with God, not through mystical techniques.**

---

## **12. The Highest Goal: Vital Union and Communion With Messiah**

**The purpose of spiritual experience is not experiences themselves.**

**The goal is deeper fellowship with Yahshua.**

**"That I may know him." (Philippians 3:10)**

**"Messiah within you, the hope of glory." (Colossians 1:27)**

**"He that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit." (1 Corinthians 6:17)**

**"Abide in me." (John 15:4)**

**The New Testament scriptures focus on entering a special dimension where Messiah dwells. He said" Dwell within me, and I dwell within you! Abiding in Messiah is to fill yourself to overthrowing; His life, presence, power, love, wisdom, and anointing in flowing upon and through the believer, continually daily is His delight as in yours. This experience is beyond the natural because it is supernatural!**

### **A Scriptural Summary**

**The pattern repeatedly shown in Scripture is: Repentance → Faith in Messiah → New Birth → Indwelling Holy Spirit → Abiding in Messiah → Prayer → Worship → Obedience → - Spirit-Filled Living → Greater Spiritual Sensitivity & Awareness of God's Presence → Fruitfulness and Power for Ministry through the gifts of the Spirit**

**This is the biblical pathway into a life lived in the reality of the Kingdom of God and the manifest presence of Yahshua.**
