



## **FROM THE THROWN TO OUR INNER MAN!**

**The New Testament teaches that believers partake with Messiah's Oran Sphere. It teaches that the believer becomes united with Messiah and that the Holy Spirit is given in and upon each who has received the Vital Union. The Bible describes that each believer can dwell within them!**

**"Messiah in you, the hope of glory." (Colossians 1:27)**

**"Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit?" (1 Corinthians 6:19)**

**The central reality is not an "oran sphere" but the indwelling presence of God through the Holy Spirit.**

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## **Light Is a Biblical Reality**

**Scripture repeatedly describes believers as light.**

**"You are the light of the world." (Matthew 5:14)**

**"For you were once darkness, but now are you light in the Lord." (Ephesians 5:8)**

**"The path of the righteous is like the light of dawn." (Proverbs 4:18)**

**This light is first a spiritual reality. It manifests through righteousness, truth, holiness, love, and the life of God shining through the believer.**

**The Bible therefore teaches that believers genuinely carry divine light.**

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## **The Glory of God Can Rest Upon Believers**

The Bible also teaches that God's glory may rest upon His people.

"If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you." (1 Peter 4:14)

"Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you." (Isaiah 60:1)

"We all... beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory." (2 Corinthians 3:18)

This transformation is real. The more a believer abides in Messiah, the more the character, life, authority, and presence of God become evident.

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## **Abiding Creates Spiritual Manifestation**

Messiah taught that abiding in Him produces supernatural fruit.

"Abide in Me, and I in you." (John 15:4)

"He who abides in Me and I in him bears much fruit." (John 15:5)

The Greek concept of abiding means remaining, dwelling, continuing in union.

As believers abide:

- Love increases
- Faith increases
- Spiritual authority increases
- Discernment increases
- Fruit increases
- The presence of God becomes more evident

Thus, there is a biblical connection between communion with God and spiritual manifestation.

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## **Moses Demonstrates Exposure to God's Presence**

**One of the strongest biblical examples is Moses.**

**"The skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God." (Exodus 34:29)**

**This was not symbolism.**

**His face literally radiated visible glory.**

**This proves that God's presence can affect the physical realm.**

**Moses became a living testimony that divine glory can rest upon a human vessel.**

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## **The Early Church Carried a Manifest Presence**

**Acts repeatedly shows believers carrying God's presence into situations.**

**Peter**

**"They even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them." (Acts 5:15)**

**Scripture does not explicitly say the shadow healed people.**

**However, the next verse says:**

**"They were all healed." (Acts 5:16)**

**Something extraordinary accompanied Peter's ministry.**

**Paul**

**"God was performing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul." (Acts 19:11-12)**

**Handkerchiefs and aprons associated with Paul became points of contact through which God healed.**

**This demonstrates that God's power can overflow beyond the physical body of the believer.**

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## **Spiritual Authority Is Recognized in the Unseen Realm**

**Acts 19 provides remarkable evidence.**

**"Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?" (Acts 19:15)**

**Demons recognized spiritual authority.**

**This indicates that spiritual beings perceive realities about believers that human eyes often cannot see.**

**The New Testament consistently teaches spiritual rank, authority, and maturity.**

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## **God's Presence Can Surround His People**

**Several passages describe God surrounding His people.**

**"As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds His people." (Psalm 125:2)**

**"The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him." (Psalm 34:7)**

**"I will be a wall of fire around her." (Zechariah 2:5)**

**These passages support the idea that God's presence provides supernatural protection.**

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## **What We Can Say with Confidence**

**The Bible teaches:**

- ✔ Believers are light in the Lord.**
- ✔ The Holy Spirit dwells within believers.**
- ✔ God's glory can rest upon believers.**
- ✔ God's presence transforms those who behold Him.**
- ✔ Spiritual authority is recognized in the unseen realm.**
- ✔ God's power can flow through believers into others.**

- ✓ God's presence can surround and protect His people.
  - ✓ Abiding in Messiah increases spiritual fruitfulness and manifestation.
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## **From The Thrown To Our Inner Man Review:**

**The Bible teaches:**

**That every believer can embrace the presence of the Lord! It is meant to be that way. You will have living waters fill you and that living water will come out of you through you being fill to overflowing! It is Normal for believers to understand that the flow of this living stream which comes out from the master's thrown, makes it's way through the forth dimension [the Kingdom of God's realm] and is given us to be filled!**

**As believers dwells in His presence, His life, light, and glory increasingly shines in this emanation to be received by them. The reality is that divine presence is filled to overflowing within and covered without. It is the indwelling Messiah manifesting His presence through the believer.
