START-UP MEETINGS: BUILDING THE GATHERING OF BELIEVERS

Following the Pattern of the Holy Spirit Under the Headship of Messiah Yahshua

FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLE	TEACHING	KEY SCRIPTURES
1. Begin Every New Work with Prayer	Every new gathering begins by seeking the Father's will through prayer. We ask the Holy Spirit to draw those whom the Father is calling into the fellowship. The Church is gathered by God, not by human effort alone.	Acts 1:14; Acts 2:42; Luke 6:12–13; John 6:44; Colossians 4:2
2. Pray for the Father's Chosen Ones	Pray continually for those whom God is preparing to become part of the local body. The Holy Spirit knows every person He is calling and prepares their hearts before they arrive.	John 17:6; John 17:20–21; Acts 2:47; Acts 13:48
3. Follow the Holy Spirit's Pattern	Never force growth. Follow the direction of Messiah Yahshua, the Head of the Church, allowing Him to build His Body according to His perfect design and timing.	Matthew 16:18; Acts 13:2–4; Acts 16:6–10; Ephesians 5:23
4. Be Patient with God's Timing	Building a healthy congregation takes time. The Lord adds people at the right time for His purposes. Spiritual growth is a process directed by Him.	Ecclesiastes 3:1; Acts 2:47; 1 Corinthians 3:6–7; James 5:7–8
5. Every Believer is Assigned by God	Every believer who becomes part of the fellowship has been given gifts, grace, and a purpose within the Body of Messiah. No member is unnecessary.	1 Corinthians 12:18; Romans 12:4–8; Ephesians 4:7
6. Every Believer Carries Spiritual Gifts	Each person is entrusted with gifts from the Holy Spirit to strengthen, encourage, and build up the congregation. These gifts are given for the common good.	1 Corinthians 12:4–11; 1 Peter 4:10–11; Romans 12:6–8
7. Every Believer is to Grow into Ministry	The goal is not simply attendance but transformation. Every disciple is equipped, developed, and released into ministry according to God's calling.	Ephesians 4:11–16; 2 Timothy 2:2; Colossians 1:28
8. The Body Functions Together as One	Every member works together under Messiah as one Body, each supplying what the others need in love and unity.	1 Corinthians 12:12–27; Ephesians 4:15–16; Romans 12:5
9. Gather in One Place and One Accord	Unity of purpose, worship, prayer, and love creates an atmosphere where the Holy Spirit moves freely among His people.	Acts 1:14; Acts 2:1; Acts 2:46; Acts 4:24, 32
10. One Mind and One Soul	Believers pursue humility, love, and agreement, placing the Kingdom above personal preferences.	Acts 4:32; Philippians 2:1–5; Romans 15:5–6
11. Messiah-Centered Worship	Every gathering is centered on the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Messiah Yahshua is recognized as the living Head of His Church, present among His people.	Matthew 18:20; Colossians 1:18; Hebrews 12:2; John
