



The Orah Sphere: The Atmosphere of the Manifest Presence of Messiah

The Orah Sphere may be understood as scripture says in 1 John chapter 1:6&7; the spiritual atmosphere where the believers live consciously dwelling in communion with Messiah Yahshua through the Holy Spirit. It is an experience of swelling in His presence.

Messiah declared:

"Dwell in me, and I will Dwell in you." (John 15:4)

The greatest miracle is dwelling in God's presence; living in continual fellowship with Him!

Our First Dimension: Awareness of God

Every believer who is dwelt by the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:9). As the believer turns his or her heart toward God in worship, prayer, and obedience, they become aware of His presence.

This awareness may be explained as:

- an encounter with the deep bliss of his spirit

- anointing resting upon
- filling with joy
- divine reverence
- conviction of sin for repentance
- renewed and refilling of love for Messiah
- increased power of faith

Scripture emphasizes that these experiences are valuable when they lead to greater obedience and Messiahlike in walk and character.

The Second Dimension: The Flow of Divine Life

Yahshua said:

"I am come that they might have life [KHIA], and that they might have it more abundantly." (John 10:10)

The Greek word *zoē* refers to the life of God Himself.

As believers dwell in Messiah:

- His very Life is poured upon and within – this is His enminating life through dwelling!
- His love begins flowing in and through us.
- His wisdom becomes our rhema which guides their decisions.
- His strength fills and sustains us.
- His joy becomes our joy which is overwhelming.
- His shalom guards their hearts.

Paul described this reality:

"It is no longer I who live, but Messiah lives in me." (Galatians 2:20)

The Messianic life is not a mere visitation but he seeks a regular habitation with us; a continuing participation in His life through the Holy Spirit!

The Third Dimension: Transformation by Glory

Paul wrote:

"We all...beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory." (2 Corinthians 3:18)

As believers we are called continually to behold our Messiah through worship, meditating Scripture, praying throughout your day, and following faithfully in His leading, living out obedience, the Holy Spirit progressively shapes use to be more and more in His likeness!

This transformation affects:

- thoughts
 - desires
 - attitudes
 - speech
 - actions
 - relationships
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The Kingdom of God Within

Yahshua taught:

"The kingdom [presence] of God is in your midst" (or "upon you, within you,"

(Luke 17:21).

The kingdom is God's reign is through the Holy Spirit, believers begin to experience His presence and His rule leading us in their lives.

The Second Sript describes the kingdom as a dimension which we are to partake of. This partaking is life changing:

- righteousness
 - shalom
 - joy in the Holy Spirit (Romans 14:17)
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The Actions Of Being Filling and Refilling

Scripture distinguishes between the Spirit's indwelling and repeated fillings and refillings which fills us to overflowing moving us to express worship, witness, and service.

The apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit on multiple occasions (Acts 2:4; Acts 4:31).

This ongoing filling produces:

- fresh boldness
- renewed love
- spiritual strength
- exercise with the gifts and fruits of the Spirit!
- wisdom
- endurance
- joyful worship

Our awareness is not always sensitive enough to detect the Spirit of God.

Believers need to sense on a continually basis the fullness to the Spirit's work! We are called to carry His presences and this means to continue to be filled and refilled with His Spirit. Some pray in heavenly tongues three times a day like david did [Psalm 55:17] and worshiped seven times a day!

Spiritual Communion with Messiah

Prayer is a speaking to God with our heart.

Communion includes:

- speaking
- listening
- worship
- thanksgiving
- meditation
- adoration
- surrender

- obedience

These are required in communion. As we continue, we increase in spiritual sensitivity in our awareness that Messiah is present.

Walking in the Light

John writes:

"If we walk in the light [Orah Sphere], as he is in the light [Orah Sphere], we have fellowship one with another..." (1 John 1:7)

The word in this passage; “light” in the Greek language means “Orah Sphere!”

Walking in God's light means living in communion with the presence of God!

1 John 6 says this person was not in the [Orah Sphere] presence, The one not in the light is apart from God's presence walking in darkness, and not in Vital Union!

Spiritual Benefits of Abiding in Messiah

The Second Scriptures attributes many blessings to abiding in Messiah Yahshua, including:

- in vital union
- walking in assurance
- experenimg divine presence
- increasing renewal and bliss
- rhema wisdom proseedng daily
- spiritual discernment and guidance
- answered prayers by God's will
- growth in transformation
- powerful boldness in witness
- spiritual gifts
- spiritual fruit

- endurance when dealing with problems
- hope of things
- love for others
- greater conformity to Yahshua

These blessings are not earned but flow from dwelling, continuing and remain in Him!

A Note on the "Fourth Dimension"

New Testament teaches that through Messah believers have:

- access to the Father (Ephesians 2:18)
- confidence to enter God's presence (Hebrews 10:19–22)
- fellowship with the Holy Spirit by Dwelling (2 Corinthians 13:14)
- citizenship in God's kingdom - experiencing the realm of the Holy Spirit (Philippians 3:20)



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
